We had one snowmobile casualty on the trail when Tyler's sled broke the chain tensioner, but it did it right on the trail instead of off in the deep, which was nice! Some creative tool use got the cover off and the chain out so it would roll, and he enjoyed a nice 6 mile tow back

down to the parking area. For a guy loading the second of two broken sleds on his trailer, he was still in good spirits, and I'm sure he'll be back for more fun in the future!


